Aloha e nā Mākua,

Mahalo for your interest in Kamehameha Schools Preschools. To provide a safe and healthy learning environment, please provide the information listed below in order for your keiki to be medically cleared to attend school. All medical clearance is done through our Electronic Health Record (EHR) Parent Portal, Mo'omō'ali Olakino at <https://ohana.ksbe.edu> using your KS Account login or via Quick Links on the IC parent portal. Through the EHR Parent Portal, you can see the medical clearance requirements, download/upload required documents, and track completion.

**All NEW Students must provide:**

- Completed Kamehameha Schools Preschools Health Record form based on a physical examination that was done on or after **July 1, 2023**.
- Kamehameha Schools Preschools Health Record Supplement form completed on or after **July 1, 2023**.\*

\*If the Health Record Supplement indicates that a Special Care Plan (SCP) is needed, a completed SCP form is also required. Please note that an epinephrine auto-injector (e.g. EpiPen) is the only medication that Preschool Staff will administer as part of a SCP.

- Documentation for being fully vaccinated for the following must be on the Kamehameha Schools Preschools Health Record form or if generated from an electronic medical record may be attached to it:
  - Diphtheria-Tetanus-Pertussis (DTP or DTaP)
  - Haemophilus Influenza B (HIB)
  - Hepatitis A
  - Hepatitis B
  - Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR)
  - Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV)
  - Polio (IPV or OPV)
  - Varicella (chickenpox)
- Tuberculosis clearance issued after twelve (12) months of age

**Please note a change to our KS Health Record and Health Record Supplement forms regarding history of COVID.** This is important from a medical perspective so our staff can care for your child knowing full medical history and can help monitor for any potential post-COVID complications that might arise. If your KS health forms do not have the history of COVID questions on them, you have an outdated version.
